2010 CENTRAL PACIFIC NON-QUALIFYING COMPETITION

General Event Information

The Central Pacific Non-qualifying Competition will be held in conjunction with the 2010 Central Pacific Regional Championships on October 16 – 17, 2009 at the Salt Lake City Sports Complex, 645 Guardsman Way, Salt Lake City, Utah and is hosted by Salt Lake Figure Skating. This competition is sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and any rule changes posted on the US Figure Skating website. The Salt Lake Sports Complex has two Olympic size rinks. The surface is 200' x 100' with rounded corners.

The Central Pacific Non-qualifying Competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of U.S. Figure Skating. This competition will be governed by all rules applicable to the 2009-2010 competitive season. The Chief Referee's interpretation of the rules and decisions on all questions not covered by these rules shall be final.

After the close of entries, September 1, 2009, there will be absolutely no refunds, for any reason, by direction of the governing council. A detailed schedule (subject to change) will be posted on the Salt Lake Figure Skating website, www.saltlakefigureskating.com.

Eligibility to Enter the Competition

Competitors must be current members of U.S. Figure Skating and have permission of their home club. Further eligibility is determined by test and age qualifications as per current U.S. Figure Skating rules. Age and test requirements must be met as of the close of entries on Sept. 1, 2009. Competitors may be required to provide a birth certificate as proof of age, if requested. Competitors from all Regions are eligible to compete at the 2010 Central Pacific Non-qualifying competition.

Groups and Final Rounds

Events having a large number of entries will be divided into groups by age as appropriate. There will be no final rounds for any of the events offered in the non-qualifying competition. All non-qualifying events offered at this competition will be judged under the 6.0 system. Medals will be awarded to 1st – 4th place.

Admission / Credentials

Competitors will receive complimentary credentials for 1 chaperone and 1 designated US Figure Skating/PSA member coach. These credentials are non transferable. You must have credentials to enter the Salt Lake City Sports Complex. Additional spectator tickets can be pre-ordered using the credential/event ticket order form (Form NQ-C). Any lost badges will be replaced at the registration desk for \$25.00.

Use the enclosed form (Form NQ-C) to order your complimentary badges and also to pre-order any additional badges. All badges will be issued under the skater's name and must be submitted by the entry deadline.

Admission will be charged for all events. One-day tickets will be available for purchase at the door.

Adults: \$10.00, Children (12 and under): \$8.00, Children (5 and under): Free

All Event tickets can be purchased on the pre order form or purchased at the door.

Adults: \$25.00, Children (12 and under): \$20.00, Children (5 and under): Free

Registration

A registration table will be inside the Salt Lake City Sports Complex. Competitors are required to register to receive their credentials. Music must be turned in at the time of registration in order to receive a credential.

Coaches Registration/Credentials

In accordance with current rules, all coaches participating in this event must be registered with U.S. Figure Skating. For more information on the registration process, please visit www.usfigureskating.org. We will provide all registered coaches with a credential. Every coach in attendance will be required to check in at the registration table and must show a picture I.D. to receive their credential. We strongly recommend that you also bring any registration confirmation materials. Coaches must wear their badge at all times when coaching skaters at rinkside of a sanctioned competition. Monitors will be instructed to ensure that anyone standing rinkside has their credential.

Official Bulletin Board

An official bulletin board will be maintained in the lobby area of the Salt Lake City Sports Complex and will contain official information only. Notices posted on this board are considered sufficient notice to all competitors. The bulletin board should be checked frequently for any changes in the schedule.

Music

CDs are the only acceptable forms of media. Cassettes will NOT be accepted. CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds. Due to compatibility and reliability reasons music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.

All competitors must have at least one (1) additional copy (CD) rinkside at practice sessions as well as rinkside during the actual competition event. The LOC will accept no responsibility for damage or loss of CDs.

Photography/Video

Award photos will be taken as soon as possible following the posting of results. Group photos will be taken of each event and individual photos may be arranged with the photographer.

All U.S. Figure Skating Championship Competitions (including regionals, sectionals, U.S. Junior Championships, and U.S. Championships) will be professionally videotaped and photographed. This policy applies to all events for the non-qualifying competition as well. Videotaping of the competition in any form is not permitted. Photographs are permitted for personal use only, but for the safety of the skaters, no flash photography is allowed. Any resale of photography is strictly prohibited. Thank you for your compliance with these policies.

Practice Ice

Practice Ice will be provided by Salt Lake Figure Skating. Competitors can request up to two unofficial sessions per day and one official practice per event (Form NQ-B). Sessions are 30 minutes and music is played on Official Practice only. Practice Ice fees will not be refunded unless the session is not assigned. Practice Ice Schedule will be available at www.saltlakefigureskating.com. Time permitting, additional practice ice may be purchased at the practice ice desk, located inside the Salt Lake City Sports Complex. Any sessions purchased in advanced after the competitor's event will be refunded or used as credit for additional sessions prior to event. You may purchase two (2) sessions per day per skater. Extra sessions that still have availability can be purchased during the competition from the practice ice desk.

Practice Ice (30 minutes): \$12.00 in advance/\$15.00 at Practice Ice Desk

Official Practice Ice (30 minutes, MUSIC PLAYED): \$17.00 in advance/\$20.00 at Practice Ice Desk

Souvenir Program Book / Photos & Advertisements

All competitors (qualifying and non-qualifying levels) are asked to submit (2) black & white 5 x 7 glossy photographs in a vertical pose, for inclusion in the souvenir program book. 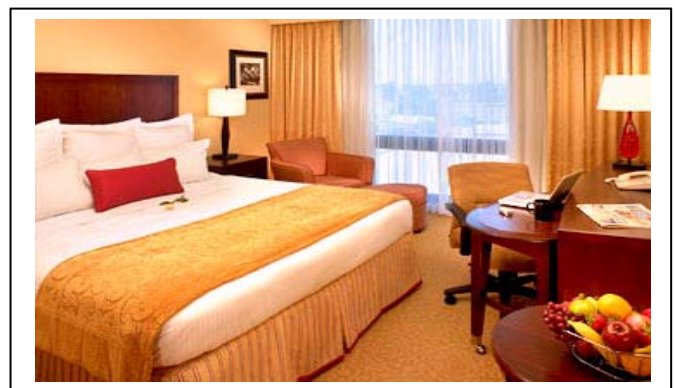

Single Free Skating

Vocal Music is permitted. All events will be scored under the 6.0 system.

Pre-Preliminary (No Axel) 10 & Under	Open to skaters 10 years of age and under who have passed their pre-preliminary freeskate test, but not their preliminary free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3711, except for no axel permitted. Duration: 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Pre-Preliminary (No Axel) 11 & Older	Open to skaters 11 years of age and over who have passed their pre-preliminary freeskate test, but not their preliminary free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3711, except for no axel permitted. Duration : 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Pre-Preliminary 10 & Under	Open to skaters 10 years of age and under who have passed their pre-preliminary freeskate test, but not their preliminary free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3711. Duration: 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Pre-Preliminary 11 & Older	Open to skaters 11 years of age and over who have passed their pre-preliminary freeskate test, but not their preliminary free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3711. Duration : 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Preliminary 10 & Under	Open to skater 10 years of age and under who have passed their preliminary freeskate test, but not their pre-juvenile free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3701, also see changes made at 2009 Governing Council to well balanced program requirements. Duration: 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Preliminary 11 & Older	Open to skaters 11 years of age and older who have passed their preliminary freeskate test, but not their pre-juvenile free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3701, also see changes made at 2009 Governing Council to well balanced program requirements. Duration: 1 min 30 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Pre-Juvenile	Open to skaters who have passed their pre-juvenile freeskate test, but not their juvenile free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3691 and as amended at 2009 Governing Council, to reduce the maximum number of jumps to five. Duration: 2 min program [+ / - 10 seconds]
Open Juvenile	Open to skaters 13 years of age or older who have passed their juvenile freeskate test, but not their intermediate free skate test. Program in accordance with Rule 3680. Duration: 2 min 15 sec program [+ / - 10 seconds]

Any sessions purchased in advance after the competitor's event will be refunded or used as credit for additional sessions prior to event.

- Practice ice will be available Thursday - Saturday, October 15-17, 2009.
- Use this form to register for Official Ice and Unofficial Practice Sessions.
- Sessions will be thirty (30) minutes in duration.
- If a practice ice session is full, a skater's place on that session will be held for no more than 5 minutes. After 5 minutes, we reserve the right to resell that spot, with no refund to the missing skater. Skaters should check in with the practice ice desk at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their session.
- Waiting lists will be established for all full sessions. Empty slots on a session will be filled in the order the names appear on the waiting list. If a skater is not present when the decision is made to fill the slot, the next skater on the list will be granted the spot.
- Not all unofficial practice sessions will be on the competition surface. Depending on number of entries, some competition events may be held on the East ice surface. Every attempt will be made to accommodate skaters and to assign practice ice on the appropriate rink.
- Practice ice fees will not be refunded unless a session is not assigned or the skater purchased in advance for practice sessions scheduled after their competition event.

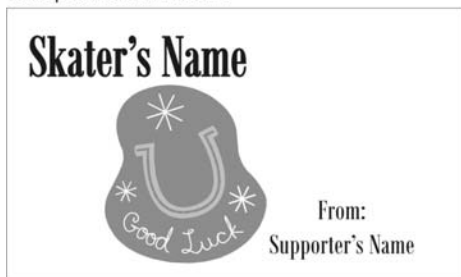

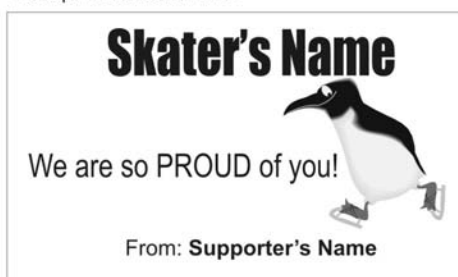
