Adult Skaters

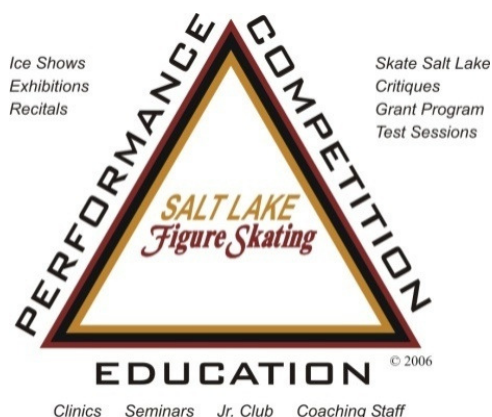
